The conference will feature general paper sessions and a working group session.

Papers are to be submitted through EasyChair at

https://easychair.org/my/conference?conf=wise16. The submissions for WISE16 will be reviewed separately from IFIP SEC2023. Accepted papers will be published in the WISE16 conference proceedings. Papers must be original work, not previously published, written in English, and at most 14 pages long including references and appendices. All submissions will be reviewed double blind and must be submitted in a blinded version (author and institution information removed). Submission instructions are available on the conference website. Acceptance will be based upon originality, contribution to the field, and relevance to the conference. The conference proceedings will be published under the *IFIP Advances in Information and Communication Technology Series* by Springer (with ISBN and indexed in Scopus) and distributed at the conference.

- **Submissions for working group topics** should describe in no more than 500 words the topic of the working group, its relevance to IFIP TC11 WG11.8, the goals to be achieved during WISE, and the plans for continued collaboration after WISE.
